



There's plenty to do in Greene County!

National Museum of the US Air Force – (3 hours) – *The oldest and largest military aviation museum in the world tells the story of aviation from the Wright Brother's first flight to the undefeated Stealth Fighter and, new in 2003, the story of the Cold War. The National Aviation Hall of Fame honors pioneers in the field of aviation. Free Admission. Group discounts available for IMAX theatre.*

Wright Memorial – (15 minutes) – *This historic memorial overlooks Huffman Prairie where Orville and Wilbur Wright flew their experimental airplanes and the Wright Company conducted a flying school.*

Huffman Prairie Flying Field & Interpretive Center – (1 hour) – *It was here that the Wright Brothers learned how to fly. See where the brothers successfully mastered the mechanics of controlled, powered, heavier than air flight. Visit the new Interpretive Center. A National Park Ranger will bring history to life! Free Admission.*

Wright Cycle Company – (30 minutes) – *Tour the restored Wright Cycle Shop in the historic Wright-Dunbar Neighborhood where the Wright Brothers developed many of their aviation concepts.*

Carillon Historical Park – (1 ½ hours) – *See the restored 1905 Wright Flyer III, the world's first practical airplane. This airplane made history over Huffman field in Greene County.*

LaComedia Dinner Theatre – (4 hours) – *Feast on a scrumptious dinner and end the evening by enjoying one of the many Broadway shows featured at the theatre year-round. Reservations required.*

Blue Jacket-Outdoor Epic Drama under the stars – (3 hours) *Discover W. L. Mundell's Blue Jack, the story of a white settler who chose the Shawnee way of life, and became the legendary War Chief know as Blue Jacket. Experience the thunder of live military cannons, the heart of stopping rush of galloping horses, and the moving performances of a professional cast which brings to life this epic story. Dinner is available for purchase.*

Yellow Springs, Ohio (1-3 hours or more) *The village of Yellow Springs, surrounded by beautiful parks and cliffs, is known for its regional attractions, wonderful downtown shops and interesting dining. It's culturally diverse with an emphasis on being open and friendly. Plan to spend time roaming the village streets for unique gifts of hand-thrown pottery, fiber arts, one of a kind stained glass pieces...and much much more.*

Young's Jersey Dairy – (1 or more) *Young's Jersey Dairy is a delightful locally owned and operated where ice cream is made from dairy cows at the 'farm' facility. There's something for everyone, a goat petting zoo, miniature golf, heated driving range, a farm themed gift shop, restaurant on the premises and of course great ice cream!*

Historic Clifton Mill – (1 or more) *Built in 1802, this is one of the largest water powered grist mill still in existence. With breathtaking views of the Clifton Gorge and a covered bridge you can dine on breakfast or lunch on a home cooked meal. Browse the gift shop decorated with antiques from a bygone era. Tour the working mill on each hour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. from March 1st to October 1st.*

The Mall at Fairfield Commons *Visit the shops, boutiques and an incredible array of department stores. A full range of services are available to compliment your shopping experience. A Dining Court on the second level offers an assortment of foods for your palette.*
