Gentlemen:

As an additional safety feature we have developed and will install an ash tray cover on all airplanes beginning with serial 108-2413.

It is recommended that this cover be installed in those airplanes in the field that were delivered without this relinement. The part number of this cover is 108-3092099 and a set for each simplane affected is available without charge from our Service Department.

For correct installation the following procedure should be observed:


- Remove ash tray and retainer attached to the sidewall trim. 1.
- Enlarge hole in trim sufficiently to accommodate cover. 2.
- Remove window sill at top of trim panel to permit access to Tinnerman nuts when reassembling ash tray retainer and cover to sidewall trim.
- Modify retainer as shown on figure 1 so that retainer will seat in cover.
- Insert cover and ash tray retainer, and secure to sidewall trim with new screws and Tinnerman nuts in the manner of the original installation. The nuts must be inserted from shove using long nosed pliers.
- Reinstall window sill.
- Modify ash tray lower lugs as shown on figure 1 so that ash tray will fit in retainer, and insert ash tray.

2 108-3092099 Cover-Ash Tray

4 AN530-6R8 Screw 4 Al181-6Z-1 Tinnerman Nut
